The meeting was started by welcoming all the members and the agenda was discussed and actions taken are as under-

Agenda No. 1: Confirmation of the proceedings of 21st MIDH meeting.

3.2 Progress of components under Area Expansion, Floriculture, Horticulture Mechanization, IPM/INM, Vending carts & Pollination support through Bee-Keeping was not up to the mark. MD instructed all MS, DHMIUs to achieve the targets till 15th March 2017. He further desired to conduct a meeting on 22nd March 2017 to review the final progress made under these components.
