The meeting was started by welcoming all the members and the agenda was discussed and actions taken are as under:-

## Agenda No. 1: Confirmation of the proceedings of 34th MIDH meeting.

The minutes of 34th MIDH meeting which was held on dated 08.02.2018 were circulated vide memo no.6895-6930/Hort-APO/NHM/5/XI/III dated 15.02.2018.As no comments were received from any quarter, so the minutes of 34th meeting were confirmed.

## Agenda No. 2: Action Taken Report of previous meetings.

The action taken report on the decisions taken in the previous meetings of MIDH was reviewed in detail and the following decisions were taken:-

#### Agenda No. 3: Review of progress of MIDH for the year 2017-18 up to February, 2018.

The District-wise & component-wise Physical & Financial expenditure was reviewed by Mission Director. The following decisions were taken during review of components:

MD instructed all MS, DHMIUs to achieve the targets as per the Revised Annual 3.1. Action Plan. The excess & surrender within components were discussed & finalized in the house.

(Action taken by: All MS, DHMIUs)

- On the basis of manufacturing cost of the following items at IBDC Ramnagar, it 3.2. was decided in house that:
  - (i) Raw honey will be processed with a cost of Rs. 5/Kg (at par with HAIC R&D Center Murthal, Sonipat).
  - (ii) The bottling & labeling will be charged at Re. 1/bottle.
  - (iii) The comb foundation sheet will be charged at Rs. 25/sheet.
  - (iv) Honey testing package (a set of 12 tests) will be charged at Rs. 3000/package.
  - (v) The cost of super bee-hives (Tun: Rs.1800/box, Pine wood: Rs. 2000/box & Kail wood: Rs. 2500/box) will be charged.

(Action taken by: DDH/IBDC)

It was decided in the house that the 40% assistance on Bee-keeping equipments 3.3. under MIDH for the year 2017-18 will be given by DBT with the coordination of Atulya honey FPO in the presence of DDH/IBDC. The physical verification by DDH/IBDC will be considered for release of assistance by MS, DHMIUs in this component.

(Action taken by: DDH/IBDC & All MS, DHMIUs)

MD informed the house that there is a target of 10 bee-breeders during current 3.4. financial year. For this, an advertisement has been given in newspapers. A committee of DDH/IBDC, a representative of CCS, HAU, PPO & Atulya honey FPO has also been constituted to finalize the names, accordingly.

3.5. MD instructed DDH/IBDC to submit the proposal for outsourcing of activities at IBDC Ramnagar within 15 days.

3.6. MD instructed all MS, DHMIUs to achieve 100% targets as per their revised AAP 2017-18 otherwise accountability of concern will be fixed accordingly.

(Action taken by: All MS, DHMIUs)

3.7. Under the component of Adoption & Certification of Organic farming, AFC has completed the projects in Bhiwani, Gurugram, Narnaul, Jhajjar & Palwal districts. MD instructed concerned MS, DHMIUs to follow up the same accordingly. (Action taken by: MS, DHMIU Bhiwani, Gurugram, Narnaul, Jhajjar & Palwal)

3.8. MD instructed all MS, DHMIUs that if there are protected structures uprooted by farmers in field then strict action as per norms & guidelines should be taken against such farmers.

3.9. In revised AAP 2017-18, a target of 100 ha. under the component of Aromatic plants has been given to district Hisar, the performance under this component at Hisar is unsatisfactory. If any targets under this component are required by other MS, DHMIUs then it can be transferred.

3.10. Some DHCs were absent in the meeting, MD instructed Establishment Officer to call explanation of such DHCs.
